

## ENVIRONMENTAL POLICY STATEMENT

- Be aware of and comply with all legislation, regulations and codes of practice on all environmental matters that are relevant to its operation and to inform its staff accordingly
- To ensure that suitable emergency procedures are in place to deal with the unlikely occurrence of an incident involving the Control of Substances Hazardous to Health regulations 2002
- As far as is reasonably practicable and consistent with its Client's instructions, ensure that activities under its control are employing methods and equipment which minimise pollution (such as noise, fumes or dust for example)
- Conserve resources, promote the reduction of waste by carefully controlling procurement and disposal, promote the reuse of any unavoidably spare construction materials by careful storage and recycling, monitoring energy consumption and minimising road vehicle movements wherever possible in preference for shared or public transport
- Ensure that the disposal of all waste material complies with the Controlled Waste Regulations
- Seek specialist advice where particular pollution problems are envisaged or encountered.
- Regularly review the progress made in achieving environmental objectives and targets.

The undersigned Directors certify that they are in support of this policy and its implementation throughout the Company and that it is current and will be reviewed regularly to ensure that it is operating effectively and efficiently and addresses the relevant and any emerging issues.
